

Subject: Spring Testing (PSAT/SAT/AP Information)

Parents, we wanted to give you some information and updates on the test opportunities coming this Spring at Wheaton Academy. If you have a student in an AP class, please review the AP test dates and information carefully. Thank you!

PSAT / SAT

On Tuesday, April 13 we will host the PSAT 8/9 for Freshman, the PSAT 10 for Sophomores and the SAT with Writing for Juniors. The SAT that juniors take is a valid test score that can be used in the college application process. Please note that the SAT will include the writing portion of the exam. The school day will start at the same time (7:55 a.m.), and as the testing date approaches, we will be in touch with more details on what to bring to school that along with the day's schedule. We are still planning on what the day will look like for seniors. Please stay tuned for more information.

Any families who receive scholarship assistance from the Invest in Kids act need to plan on having their student present for testing on April 13. As part of the scholarship program, it is expected that the school is tracking student growth and achievement through the PSAT/SAT testing. AP Exams

This year the College Board decided to offer AP exams in a new and expanded format to meet student needs given the challenges of the previous year of high school education. Accordingly, each exam is now being offered at three different times in May and June, and some exams are being offered digitally. You can find the full AP Exam schedule here:

Over the past several weeks we have solicited feedback from our AP teachers about which exam date would best fit the scope and sequence of the class and allow for maximum student preparedness. Please refer to the chart below to see when we will be preparing students for and offering each exam. AP teachers will be communicating these dates and expectations with students in class. It is possible for individual students to elect to take their AP exam on one of the other dates offered by College Board (a student might want to do this because it allows for more time to prepare or potentially would allow for a different format). If your student is interested in taking the AP exam on a different date than the one noted below, please notify Davona Reynolds (dreynolds@wheatonacademy.org) of the change by Thursday, March 11.

If an AP exam is located at Wheaton Academy, it is a paper exam and students will need to be at Wheaton Academy the date of the exam. If the AP exam is offered digitally, students will be taking those exams at home and need to ensure reliable internet connectivity and a quiet testing environment.
