Additionally, please review the information below regarding Surface Pro 6 laptops, transcripts, and diplomas:

**Surface Pro 6:** Please help us ensure your senior student returns their Surface and accessories in time for us to reset them for incoming freshmen (please note, no personal data is retained). All seniors must return the Surface Pro 6, case, pen, charger, and keyboard to the Wheaton Academy I.T. department during the week of May 24, no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 28. Seniors who are taking final exams may return their devices the following week (June 1-4), no later than noon on Friday, June 4. All stickers (except the serial number barcode) must be completely removed.

Fees for damaged or missing Surfaces or Accessories (*diplomas and transcripts are withheld until full payment is received*):

- damaged Surface Pro (in case) \$200
- damaged Surface Pro (not in case) \$450
- damaged or missing Surface Pro Type Cover (keyboard) – full replacement of identical keyboard [Microsoft FMM-00001 Type Cover for Surface Pro – Black](#)), or \$130
- damaged or missing black Surface pen \$20
- damaged or missing Surface Pro power supply (must be a WA-issued power supply) \$30
- damaged or missing Surface Pro case, full replacement of identical case [Kensington Surface Pro 7 Rugged Case - Surface Pro 7, 7+, 6, 5, 4 \(K97951WW\), Black](#), or \$40

If necessary, it may be most cost-effective for the Keyboard and case to purchase a replacement in advance on Amazon and turn it in with the Surface Pro on or before Friday, May 28. Questions?
