Inspired by their founder Pastor Bawi, for each roll of sushi sold, they provide a meal to an orphan in Myanmar. They maintain a secondary social purpose of providing meaningful employment to Burmese and all underserved in varying positions in our company. Wheaton Academy is now affiliated in this purpose as well, simply by offering sushi alongside our existing cafeteria fare.

Launched locally on March 2, 2021, the first independently owned location provides wholesale distribution of sushi across Chicagoland for area hospitals, colleges/universities, corporate settings as well as select private retail locations.
