

Returning Families,

**The financial aid process at Wheaton Academy is officially open for the 2024-2025 school year. Like last year, the deadline for a returning family's financial aid application for the 2024-2025 school year is December 31, 2023.**

This timeline allows Wheaton Academy to grant aid awards to returning families before new family aid awards are considered, as over 80% of our financial aid awards are distributed in February.

**Like last year, we have partnered with the financial aid processing company—Blackbaud Financial Aid. This portal better integrates with the internal systems Wheaton Academy already uses, making it an easier process for both you and our staff.**

Our records indicate that your family received a financial aid award through a tax credit scholarship this year. As you may already know, **the Invest in Kids Act Tax Credit Scholarship Program is under review with current Illinois lawmakers.** It is possible that this program could end with the upcoming vote. This scholarship program has been a blessing to our school community over the years. It is a vehicle through which our school has provided over \$1 million in scholarships to students each year, and **its potential end has implications to our financial aid program.** As a past applicant or recipient of these scholarship funds from Empower IL, we will keep you updated with any potential implications for your family regarding the vote. **No matter the outcome, please know we are committed to partnering with you to keep Wheaton Academy affordable to your family.**

To be considered for an aid award for the 2024-2025 school year, **we require your family to re-apply through the Blackbaud Financial Aid application starting November 1, 2023 and before December 31, 2023.** Then, we will guide you through the tax credit scholarship application as information becomes available.

## YOUR FINANCIAL AID CHECKLIST

### **1 Complete the required Blackbaud Financial Aid application by December 31, 2023**

Login through your existing Blackbaud Financial Aid account. You may be prompted to verify your information via email or text before you can log-in.

- Submit the Blackbaud Financial Aid application and upload supporting documentation to the application portal by December 31, 2023**

We suggest gathering this paperwork before you apply to ease the application process.

The required documentation could include:

- Most recent W2 per working parent per job
- Most recent pay stubs per working parent per job
- Most recently filed federal tax returns (including 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ with all schedules). Wheaton Academy permits families to use their 2022 tax returns to apply for financial aid considering the December 31 deadline.
- Note: Your family may need to provide further documentation for your family's unique circumstances.

## □ Confirm receipt of the Blackbaud Financial Aid application

The status of your aid application can be found on the homepage upon log-in.

*Please note that Blackbaud Financial Aid takes several weeks to process finished applications and verify submitted documentation. **The Blackbaud Financial Aid portal will directly email families reminders to complete any outstanding items, so please look for these notifications and respond accordingly.***

## 2 If prompted, complete the Empower IL tax-credit scholarship application in January 2024

The Wheaton Academy Business Office will use the information from your family's completed Blackbaud Financial Aid application to pre-screen your family's possible qualification for a 2024-2025 tax credit scholarship, should the Invest In Kids Act remain intact.

### Important Instructions as You Apply Through Blackbaud Financial Aid

- Please use **legal names** as you complete the aid application so the names appearing on this application will match the names Wheaton Academy has on file.
- Please enter **annual values** unless otherwise requested as you complete the application.
- Be sure to **add all dependents** on the financial aid application, not just those applying for aid at Wheaton Academy.
- In Household Information, within Section C, "Select a School," please enter **school code 12646** to represent Wheaton Academy and to avoid searching for the school.
- Be sure to select **"Save and Continue"** within each section to save your progress, should you need to revisit the application later.
- Once you submit your application, it can be **viewed but no longer edited**.
  - Once you submit the application, the confirmation page will then list the **additional documentation** your family needs to submit to officially complete the process.
  - These items can be uploaded under "Documentation" in the main tool bar of Blackbaud Financial Aid Management.

### What Happens Next?

The Wheaton Academy Financial Aid Committee will then issue financial aid award decisions to families beginning **mid-February 2024**. Should the Invest in Kids Act remain intact, this timing mirrors the start of tax credit scholarship awarding. However, Empower IL exclusively determines the timing and prioritization of tax credit scholarship awards. The Committee will work closely with our representatives from Empower IL to learn of their timing and awarding.

*Please note: Awards are distributed as funds are available. There may be a season of a financial aid waitpool for families, even after awards begin to be issued. Thanks in advance for your patience should this possibility become a reality.*

## SOME COMMON QUESTIONS

**Q: Will my family receive the same financial award as last year?**

**A:** Current families who pay reduced tuition because of financial aid can expect to receive similar levels of funding each year if their financial circumstances remain the same. Typically, families pay part of any annual tuition increase. However, every family must re-apply for financial aid each year and meet all stated deadlines.

Finally, funding for the tax-credit scholarship is directly related to the Invest In Kids Act remaining intact and the amount of funds donated to the scholarship granting organization. It is possible that less funds will be available, and a family's total aid award may have to be reduced as a result.

**Q: Why do I have to apply through Blackbaud Financial Aid if my family's financial aid award comes from a scholarship granting organization? Do I have to complete BOTH applications?**

**A:** We require families to complete both applications to ensure the best possible financial aid award for your family. In the event that more families apply for tax-credit scholarships than funds available, your family's completed Blackbaud Financial Aid application will allow our Financial Aid Committee to immediately explore other avenues of funding. Additionally, the pre-screening made possible through a completed Blackbaud Financial Aid application greatly aids the Business Office's provided guidance.

**Q: Who should complete this Blackbaud Financial Aid application?**

**A:** Whomever the child resides with should complete the Blackbaud Financial Aid application whether it is a parent, grandparent, aunt/uncle, or legal guardian. There is a section within the application where you can enter contributions from non-custodial parents and relatives.

**Q: Why do I need to input my spouse's information if I am remarried, and they are not legally responsible for my children?**

**A:** Blackbaud Financial Aid Management's calculation works off the total household income, therefore including all income, whether the party is legally responsible for your children or not. The system, however, does take into effect your spouse's expenses as well as their income. It is important to list all expenses that are asked of within the application.

**Q: I am applying another student for the 2024-2025 school year? Is there a separate process for new students?**

**A:** No—your family's Blackbaud Financial Aid application should include both your returning student(s) and new student(s). Additionally, your family's financial aid award amount may be re-evaluated considering your family's increased enrollment.

**Q: I need help completing my Blackbaud Financial Aid application. Who do I contact?**
