**** If you have accommodations on the test, please ask your parents about information they received in their email about the timing of the day.***

What to Bring:

- **School-issued computer (fully charged) with Bluebook application downloaded before test day**
- **Power cord**
- **Pen or pencil (for writing on scratch paper)**
- **Acceptable calculator**—for use on the Math section of the test (if you prefer using a handheld calculator to using the embedded Desmos calculator in the Bluebook app)

Other Notes:

1. Please make sure your student has a good breakfast that morning.
2. There will not be Wheaton Academy lunch available on test day, due to the early dismissal.
3. Students may have a drink or food snack in between testing sections if they pack this and bring it with them the day of the test. They would need to put it away under their desk at the end of each break. There will not be lunch provided during the time of the test. So, snacks are recommended during breaks.
4. Students will not be able to check their cell phones for the entire time of the test.
5. You may pick up your student as soon as they are dismissed from their testing rooms.

We recommend that students review the [PSAT NMSQT Student Guide](#) or [8/9 Student guide](#) and test preparation information found online at <https://satsuite.collegeboard.org/practice> to feel ready for test day. Important information is given in the SAT Student guide such as the reminder that there is no penalty for guessing, and students are encouraged to give their best answer to every question.

Students will download the Bluebook Application on their computers during their English class soon. Please ensure that your student is in attendance on October 9 + 10 to complete this essential step to be ready for test day.
