### What to Bring to all school testing day:

- **School-issued computer (fully charged)**
- **Power cord**
- **Pen or pencil (for writing on scratch paper)**
- **Calculator (for use on the Math section of the test)**

### Other Notes:

1. Please make sure your student has a good breakfast that morning.
2. There will not be Wheaton Academy lunch available on test day, due to the early dismissal.
3. Students may have a drink or food snack in between testing sections if they pack a snack and bring it with them the day of the test. Students would need to put it away under their desk at the end of each break.
4. Students will not be able to check their cell phones or smart watches for the entire time of the test.
5. You may pick up your student as soon as they are dismissed from their testing rooms.
6. Students need to download the necessary testing applications, BlueBook app (for 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> grade) or TestNav app (for 12<sup>th</sup> grade), on their school-issued computers in preparation for the test. Students should have recently completed this step in English class.
