**Other Notes:**

1. Please make sure to eat a good breakfast that morning.
2. Wheaton Academy lunch will not be available on test day due to the early dismissal.
3. Students may have a drink or food (packed from home) in between testing sections. They must put it under their desk at the end of each break. There will not be lunch provided during the time of the test. So, snacks are recommended during breaks.
4. Students will not be able to check their cell phones for the entire test time.
5. You may pick up your student as soon as they are dismissed from their testing rooms.
